The committee members satisfied with the arrangement of the banners, anti ragging lecturers organized by the Institute. Further the Principal requests the Anti Ragging committee and Anti Ragging Squad members to keep strict vigilance and constant supervision so that there is no ragging issue at the campus.

The members of Anti Ragging Squad will visit every Hostel atleast on alternate days to assess the situation in the Hostels. The Members of Anti Ragging Committee will visit the Institute premises to curb ragging in any form.

The committee has decided to request all HODs, faculty members, Anti Ragging squad members and workshop instructors to explain the consequence of ragging to the 3rd and 5th semester students as follows.

1. Cancellation of Admission.
2. Suspension from attending classes.
3. Debarring from appearing in tests and examinations
4. Debarring from representing the Institute in any meet, youth festival, Etc.
5. Expulsion from the Hostels.
6. Withholding/withdrawing from scholarship.
7. Rustication from Institute.
8. Fine upto Rupees 25000/-.
9. Rigorous imprisonment upto 3 years etc.

The Principal requests the Member Secretary of Anti Ragging committee to arrange a lecture of 1 hour duration by an Advocate for the 3rd and 5th Semester students to make them aware of the consequences of Ragging as per law and also a lecture by a doctor on Clinical Psychology to make the students aware about psychological effects of ragging.
